Job Title: Youth Missions Ambassador

Report to: Executive Director

Purpose: To work within our network and with key partners to raise awareness of the mission task amongst youth and to help educate, train and equip youth for engagement in mission.

Responsibilities

1 To promote cross-cultural mission in churches with a focus on Youth.

- a. Relevant biblical teaching
- b. Liaison with and development of youth leadership
- c. Providing appropriate material to increase missional thought and engagement
- d. Supporting churches and parents in engaging in missions
- e. Equipping the church and youth leadership to enhance their church's mission interest
- 2 To raise the profile of GC3 and enhance cross-cultural mission awareness.

This can be achieved through, but not limited to:

- a. Attending and participating in mission events
- b. Deepening engagement with GC3
- c. Strengthening interest in and care of mission partners
- d. Developing a deeper prayer commitment
- e. Other opportunities as they arise
- **3** To work collaboratively with other groups and organisations to develop and deliver tools for channelling youth into mission activity in NZ and overseas
- 4 **To support our churches and the partners they send**, and to raise awareness of what GC3 can provide
- 5 **To work with the Board and Staff in developing and contributing to a Youth Programme** that focuses on mission
- 6 **To undertake any additional project or tasks** as directed by the GC3 Executive Director.
